



Dear Owners/Breeders/Trainers,

We have received your entries and are excited to have you participating in the 6th annual TwoBulls Challenge.

The event is at the Stephens Co. Expo Center which is on the south edge of Duncan, OK on old Hwy 81.

Our host hotel is the new Hampton Inn, located at 2301 N Hwy 81 in Duncan. We have arranged a special room rate with the Hampton Inn for our event. **You will need to call in your reservation at 580-255-1700 by March 9, 2009 to get this discounted price. You will need to give the promotion code of TBC when booking your reservation.**

All Derby/Classic Bulls must be checked in Thursday 3/12/09, from 2 PM noon to 5 PM. Bulls arriving after the 5 PM deadline will be fined \$100. Futurity Bulls can be checked in on Thursday as well during the times designated, or can be checked in Friday from 9 AM till 12 PM Noon. Once again Bulls arriving after the 12 PM deadline will be fined a late fee of \$100.

- Health papers required with negative TB test and a negative Brucellosis test within the same calendar year (2009) and prior to the competition date **NO EXCEPTIONS!! BEING FROM A TB FREE STATE DOES NOT EXCLUDE YOUR BULL FROM THIS!!**

You will be responsible for your own feed and water tubs. The Bulls will be kept under roof at the Expo facility and both livestock holding buildings have soft dirt pens. Shavings will be allowed and can be purchased onsite through the Fairgrounds office.

When you check in you will receive a Breeders Packet that will include one Credential badge and one companion ticket for each night for each Bull entered. You can buy additional Tickets for \$10.00. If you need additional tickets please contact our office 580-255-0710 and talk to Sharon prior to March 10th. Those can be paid for with credit card and they will be in your packet when you arrive.

The horn tipping rule will be strictly enforced for the Derby, Futurity, & Classic Bulls. The bulls are required to be a minimum of a 50 cent piece and the judges for the event will check them and disqualify them if they do not meet that criterion. So please have them in compliance as no bulls will be tipped once they are checked in.

A mandatory Contractors meeting will be held for all Derby, Futurity and Classic Bull owners/breeders/trainers at the Expo at 1:30 PM on Friday March 13th. We will discuss pertinent information about the event that you need to know.

If you are competing in the Derby/Classic event, your jockey will need to sign a Pre-Injury Release Form before he will be allowed to mount your Bull. This form will be handed out at the contractors meeting and you will be responsible for having him to sign the form and return to our secretary before the event. This is to protect you and us.

As in the past we will require each person that receives a credential to fill out a liability release form when you pick up your contestant packet. If you have partners that will be utilizing the credential to get behind the chutes they must fill out the release as well before a credential will be released to them. Once again this is to protect you and us.

The derby/classic events will be sanctioned by the PBF-Professional Bullfighters and will be a Daisy Protection Bullfight Competition. As in the past these bullfighters will NOT be allowed to turn any bulls back or do anything that will interfere with, or enhance the bulls bucking performance.

If you win a check, you will be required to fill out a W-9 form before your check is released. The W-9 forms will be included in your packet, so please have them filled out and ready for the secretary to expedite receiving your prize money check.

When you check in, please give a Phone number to our Livestock Superintendent where you can be reached in case of emergency during this event.

We are proud to host each of you in our community and wish each of you the best of luck at the TwoBulls Challenge.
